December 2, 2009

- The offer was made for 10 Members at Palmetto Hall to prepay their club dues for 3 years at a substantial savings. It was a way of saying “Thank You” to loyal members.

- The Wine tasting was a huge success.
- Different ideas are being considered for the Capital Projects for 2010. Items required for safety and items that are required by a government entity are done first.
- It has been decided that the original idea of painting yardage markers on the cart is not visible enough from the fairway so other alternatives are being considered.
- \$13,000 was just spent to repair existing carts. There is no plan to replace the carts for 2010.
- There will be no Board meeting in January. For 2010, the Board will meet every other month.
- There are 3 bad areas on the cart paths that need attention. There are plans to repair these areas in 2010. It was asked if the areas of damaged cart paths be marked so you can spot them before you actually drive over that area.
- New chairs for the ballroom should be in place by the Member Christmas Dinner/Dance.
- Why was Golf dues increased but not Social? 1) We tried not to increase unless absolutely necessary and the Food & Beverage Department was above budget for 2009 which is the only area of the club Social Members can use.
- The greens and fairways on the Cupp Course should be cut by the first of next week.
- It was stated that the bunkers looked much better.
- Membership at large can help the club’s revenue by bringing guests to the club.
- It was asked if the areas of damaged cart paths be marked so you can spot them before you actually drive over that area.
- There are several sprinkler heads that need to be remarked for distance.
- Tee markers are to be repainted.
