Board of Advisors Meeting Minutes
June 2, 2010

Attendees: Steve Baldwin, Gayle Fisher, Fred McNamee, Brad Tufts, Claude Thorn, and Michelle Kern

- The running boards on the bridge between Cupp 1 & 2 will soon be repaired.
- The tree guarding the green on Hills #12 will not be trimmed as HGG (Heritage Golf Group) can not get permission to do so.
- The area approximately 150 yards to the pin on Cupp #10 and on the far left side of the hole is not a hazard unless you are very deep into the woods (more from the #11 side) and then you probably not be able to find your ball.
- New Score Cards were ordered before HGG received the new course ratings, however, they have been programmed into the computer.
- We have not added sand to any bunkers since the last Board Meeting. Cupp #9 and Hills #15 seem to be better so possibly it is because of redistributing existing sand to the base of the bunker.
- Would it be possible for the black tee markers to be side by side or in front of the white instead of being inside them?
- It was asked if during a large club tournament if range ball could be set up on the range rather than the members having to into the golf shop to get them. This is done when possible in conjunction with a tournament on the resort course but most of the time we do not as that would mean resort guests would not have to pay for their balls.
- It was asked if 6-8 tee times could be set aside on the resort course on days of large club tournament and the answer was no. The members only have one course per day so when there is a large member event the other course is not open except to resort guests.
- It was stated that on Cupp #2, short of the lagoon on the right side that it should be marked as ground under repair since it's wet and there are usually tire ruts.
- The rough on the course are currently in much better shape than last year due to extra fertilizer being applied.
- It was stated that both courses are in great shape.
- It was stated that Grif did a great job marking the courses.
- The JPGA will be at Palmetto Hall this summer.
- HGG is fairly sure E-golf will be back next February, however, no contract has yet been signed.
- Aerification dates are: Hills-July 14 & 15, Cupp June 30 & July 1. Fairways will not be done.
- Painting and repair is being done to handrails at the golf shop and the step up to the ballroom.
