Questions, concerns, general information:

- Dues increase for 2010 will be minimal.
- March, April, May, & October are the busiest months for golf on the island. The total number of island rounds are down for 2010.
- The courses are in great shape. Over-seeding is scheduled for the Cupp course on November 2<sup>nd</sup> and the Hill course on November 16<sup>th</sup>. The courses will be closed until 11:00 am both days.

- The ground crew is planning to put the yardage markers on the cart paths this winter.
- Overall, the Mid Cap Event was good, however, there were remarks about the condition of the carts and that it would have been nice to have had towels in the carts. The food was great.
- It was also asked if towels could be put on the driving range to clean clubs after practice
- Has the course rating changed? Yes, the information was not correct in Golf Net. It has been updated so some may see a minimal difference in their handicap.
- It was mentioned that the courses restrooms are looking dingy. Claude stated that they were on his list to look over and make improvements where needed.
- It was asked if there could be additional soap dispensers in the ladies locker room sink area.
  - Due to the tremendous success of Rally for a Cure Friday Happy Hour, it was asked if it was possible to have a similar happy hour each month (no food service, appetizers only) or at least every other month.
